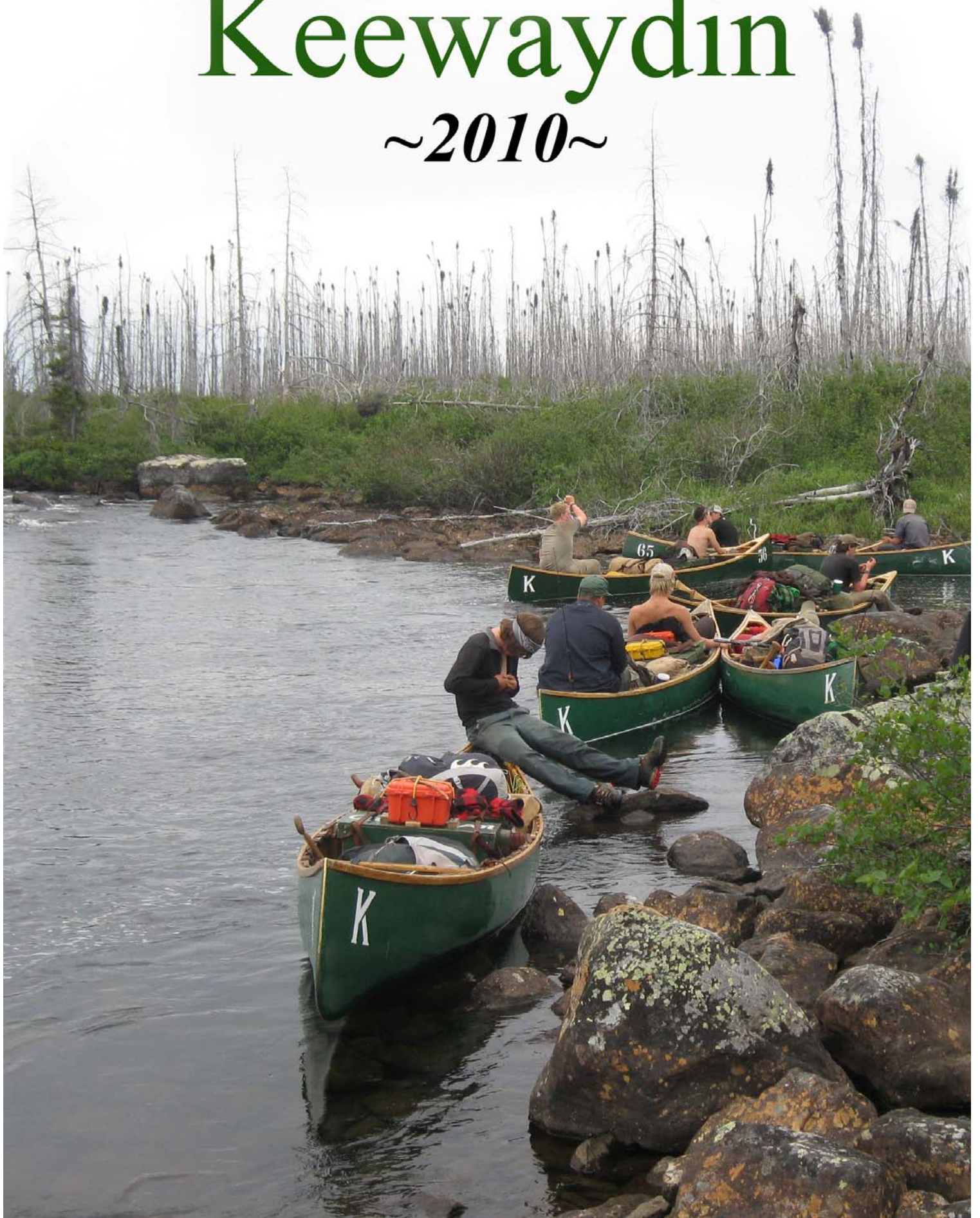

~ 2010: Keewaydin's 118th Season ~

Blueberries, blue skies, dry river beds and dry weather characterized the summer of 2010 around Temagami. Up to the north and west in Ontario and Manitoba, the water levels were high, and to the north and east in Labrador and Quebec, the weather was characteristically damp, and at times a bit frosty. Weather stories are just the beginning of any recounting of a summer at Keewaydin. Bugs, portages, rapids and meals tend to fill up the narratives and it is our hope that the pictures of this yearbook will be reminders of 2010 summer adventures and sparks for more stories.

Big was the operative term for our long trips this year with twelve campers each on Section A and Section 1 and ten on Section B. Section A traveled to the west side of Hudson Bay running the Trading River to the Marten Drinking River and then the Winisk River out to the settlement of Peawonuck on Hudson Bay, while Section 1 traveled in Quebec on the Coats River, the Little Whale River and the Guerin River, emerging on Richmond Gulf and the settlement of Umiujaq. Section B put in at Icebound Lake in Quebec and worked east, crossed from Quebec in Labrador and then traveled downstream to Menihék Lake, where they flagged down a train to take them to Sept Illes on the St. Lawrence Seaway.

Evans Outpost sections in western Ontario had an exceptional season. Section D ran the Berens River to the Keeper and then Bloodvein River, emerging on Lake Winnipeg which they crossed on a ferry. Sections E, F and G, with the Evans Outpost cabin as a base, explored the possibilities of the Wabikimi region, taking advantage of the superb whitewater and the world class fishing.

The Temagami region was hot and dry, keeping folks off the usual 21 day trip routes on the Sturgeon, the Wanapitei and the Temagami Rivers. Trips to Quebec found a bit more water and other sections explored the beauty of the Dead Lakes region to the south of Temagami. All sections found bountiful blueberry patches, great fishing for bass and walleye and dry portages that were a few meters longer than usual!

It was a fantastic season, another one for the record books and we are already looking forward to 2011 and celebrating the 100th anniversary of our Hudson Bay Trip.

A big thank you to Doc Bourdelais for collecting all of the pictures and designing this yearbook!

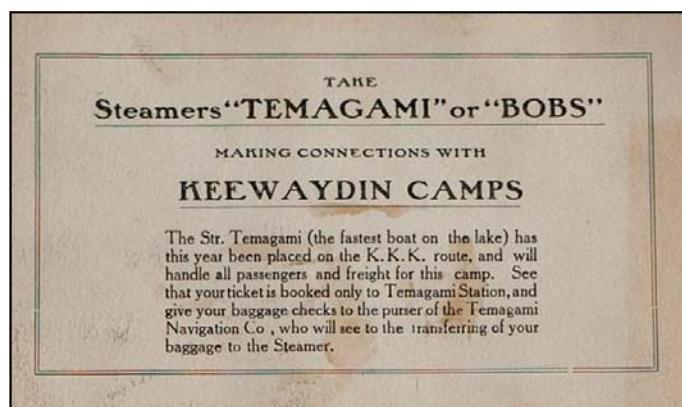
The Tenderfoot
